Intervention plan

Every child with learning or behavioral difficulties may be subject to an intervention plan. It is written by the school's teaching staff, professional staff and support staff. The parents are also invited to work on it. For 2 or 3 weeks in fall, the school team consult for implementation of these plans and we try to find solutions.

Filming children

It is important to remind everyone **not to film children or to photograph them**, except during a public event (concert, presentation). Again, we must be careful not to disseminate these images, unless you have written permission from parents.





Playground and ice

Every year, the same question comes up: should children be allowed to play outside during recreation if the court is on ice? School staff make the best decision based on the state of the court, while remembering that zero risk does not exist.

Challenge of the students which integrate the regular classes

On Novembre 20th, several staff members attended a training by education consultant. We discussed the challenges of our students entering the regular class. New country, new class, new language, these students must work hard to succeed. The resources are not always at the rendez-vous because we have been experiencing a shortage of staff.

Shortage of staff

Since the beginning of the year, a replacement in orthopedagogy for the year and a replacement of 4 months in speech therapy have still not been filled. Our team use imagination to fill this lack of personal and meet the needs of our students.

Program for new teachers

The school board has set up a vocational induction program designed to equip teachers who start this new job. Experienced teachers from our school generously accompany these young teachers.
