Presentation at l'Université de Montréal (word by the Principal)

New recommendations for coronavirus in China

On 6 February, new recommendations came into force. The Ministry of Health and Social Services recommends that travellers arriving from Hubei Province in China apply the new measures announced on February 6, 2020, by the Government of Canada. These new measures consist of applying voluntary isolation for 14 days following their departure from Hubei Province and monitoring their symptoms (fever, cough, breathing difficulties).
