 Special schedule for the beginning of the school for students in the regular sector

As a reminder, the first day of school for students in the regular sector is :

Thursday, August 26.

There is a special schedule for the arrival of students according to their level on that day.



For students in the annex (630 Saint-Roch Street)

Grade 2 students: 7:45 am

Grade 1 students: 8:15 a.m.

The regular schedule (bell at 7:50 a.m.) will begin on August 27

For students at the Barthélemy-Vimont main school (415 Saint-Roch Street)

Grades 2 and 3: 7:50 a.m.

Grade 4 students: 8:10 a.m.

Grade 5 students: 8:25 a.m.

Grade 6 students: 8:40 a.m.

The regular schedule (7:50 a.m.) will begin on August 27

Language Classes

For students in language classes, the teacher will contact the parents to set up a date and time to meet with the parents and child.

Welcome classes

For the welcome classes sector, the first day will be August 27 at 8:15 a.m.

Registration for daycare and lunch

For parents who have not yet done so, there will be a registration period (at 415 Saint-Roch Street) for the daycare and lunch services at the following times

August 23 to 25 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

August 27 from 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

It will not be possible to register your child on August 26.

Registration is required for your child to eat at school. To be eligible for the service, all balances from last year must be paid.



Registration for the food measure (\$1 lunch) will be in September. Information to come.

Extended absence for medical reasons in the context of Covid

As last year, students whose medical condition (or that of a person with whom they reside) presents a risk of serious complications if they contract COVID-19 will be able to receive educational services at a distance, when a physician recommends that these students not attend school. A recent medical bill must be presented to the school principal, even for students who received these services last year.

Requirement to notify the school of a COVID diagnosis or symptoms

If your child tests positive for COVID (or if your child or family members have symptoms), your child must stay home.
