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Weekly Educational Packages

Dear parents,

As announced by the Québec Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MEES), starting today, a weekly educational package will be made available for elementary and high school students of Québec during school closures.



Details are as follows:

- Packages are divided by grade and mandatory subject and are intended to support learning retention. They contain optional learning activities which will not be graded.
- Teachers and other members of the school team will have the opportunity to complement or improve the MEES package content with more targeted activities. If they choose to do so, an e-mail will be sent at the beginning of every week.
- The MEES teaching activities will be posted every Monday on our website. Feel free to go directly through the website to access the content.
- If they have not already, school team members will reach out to parents. A specific followup will also be done for special needs students.

We hope that these educational packages will help you to maintain a learning routine – a need many of you have expressed in the past few weeks. Please know that we have heard you.

An important reminder that in accordance with Public Health recommendations in the face of the growing pandemic, it is still forbidden to recover school supplies or personal effects from your child/children's school until further notice.
